BARGANING UPDATE

We have closed the survey and are looking through your thoughts and ideas regarding what you'd like to see updated in our contract. There were a lot of great ideas, suggestions, and many areas of growth for our district.

While sifting through the data you provided, we noted some areas of commonality between many responses. One of the more common topics that came up in our survey is the lack of classroom budgets. It was mentioned that prior to the 2008 recession, classes and departments were given a small annual budget to purchase supplies for labs, art lessons, activities, and other educational materials. During the economic crisis, these budgets were pulled back into a reduced site budget that was put into the control of each site's administrator.

Unfortunately as the economy recovered, those budgets were never re-established. Since this can be considered a working condition, it is something that we can look at for negotiations and its addition into our contract. If we look to add that, however, it is likely that the district will then counter with a reduced salary increase as they will claim that they would have less funds to offer a higher salary increase. As a recommendation, the best place to start is with a conversation with your site administrator. Each site has an operating budget to utilize annually, and there is no reason why supplies cannot be purchased with those budgets. If those conversations don't get you the results you want, feel free to invite your building rep and ultimately the TCEA president or vice president. Our goal should alway be to try to solve problems at the lowest level possible, and escalate from there.

As for the start of our negotiations process, the TCEA board will discuss the recommendations made by the membership and sunshine the associated articles with the district. We will always start with language and contract changes, and then work on salary adjustments as the state finalizes its budget in March.

Article X

Saftey Conditions Of Employment (Revised 2019-2020)

- 5. Within the first month of each school year, the district will work with the site emergency committee to check emergency bins, and emergency backpacks to ensure supplies are inventoried. The district and site safety committee will work together to prepare an inventory list as well as a report on the current condition of site's safety/emergency equipment.
- 6. Every three (3) years the district will provide an emergency training to the safety committee. Yearly, the school site will provide a training review, to ensure procedures meet the safety needs of students, and staff for the upcoming year
